

New 2012 Pfizer Clinical Trial



Circle City Veterinary Specialty and Emergency Hospital has been selected by Pfizer to participate in yet another clinical trial for treating Atopic dermatitis in the dog. This is the 6th clinical trial we have participated in with Pfizer in the past 3 years!

The current clinical trial will start the end of February, 2012. This is a double blind study to evaluate a monoclonal antibody for the treatment of Atopic dermatitis.

Each patient will be enrolled for a 42 day period and will be examined at the start of the study and every 14 days thereafter.

The clients with a qualifying patient already established in our Dermatology Department will incur no additional cost to participate. Newly referred clients will be responsible for their Initial Exam fee. All participants will receive financial compensation at the successful conclusion of their participation.

The basic requirements are as follows:

- 1) The diagnosis of Atopic dermatitis is confirmed based on history and clinical signs.
Allergy testing is optional
- 2) Dietary allergies have either been ruled out or controlled
- 3) Must be in good general health
- 4) Must be suffering at least a moderately intense level of pruritus
- 5) Must be at least 1 year of age and weigh between 2kg & 80kg.
- 6) There are required therapy withdrawal times that will be discussed with the owner prior to enrollment.
